

Sea Island Wreath Cum Yah Gullah exhibit



Make a wreath to celebrate the holidays!

What you need:

- Paper plates
- Scissors
- Green colored or construction paper
- Red crayons or markers
- Glue

What you do:

1. Cut the center from a paper plate
2. Trace your handprint on the green paper and cut out. These are the leaves for your wreath.
3. Glue on the plate and decorate with "berries"

Did you know?

The Gullah people have traditionally used natural materials in their own backyards to decorate for the holidays. Wreaths are often made from palm leaves because the plants are plentiful along the coast of the Sea Islands.
